SECTION 1: BEST PRACTICES

Follow these key tips to ensure your essay reflects your leadership potential and dedication to service:

- 1. Tell Your Story:
- Highlight experiences that shaped your character, resilience, and passion for leadership.
- Focus on specific moments that demonstrate your commitment to service and integrity.
- 2. Align with the Mission:
- Research the core values of the ROTC or academy you're applying to.
- Reflect how your goals align with their commitment to leadership, duty, and excellence.
- 3. Be Authentic:
- Write in your own voice—avoid clichés or what you think "sounds good."
- Admissions officers want to understand who you are, not a polished persona.
- 4. Structure Your Essay:
- Start with a strong opening that captures attention.
- Use a clear structure with an introduction, body, and conclusion.
- Ensure each paragraph focuses on one key idea.
- 5. Proofread and Seek Feedback:
- Revise multiple times for grammar, clarity, and flow.
- Ask a mentor, teacher, or trusted peer for constructive feedback.
